21st October 2025, Tuesday - Cape Town

- Depart for Cape of Good Hope excursion. Travel along the Atlantic seaboard to Hout Bay enroute to Cape Point.
- 10.30am
- Arrive at Cape Point. The Cape Point Reserve was started in 1936 to preserve the indigenous flora and fauna of the Cape Peninsula. The principal road through the reserve ends near the summit of Cape Point from where a walk or a funicular ride will end at the highest vantage point.
- From this position the panorama is breathtaking, encompassing the whole of False Bay and the Hottentots Holland Mountains beyond. By far the most dramatic view, however, is downward, for the vantage point is 209m above the rocks, significantly impacting all forms of marine life in the vicinity and on the peninsula's flora.
- Visit the lighthouse, which has long been one of the world's shipping beacons, marking the turning point between the Atlantic and Indian Oceans.

- Depart Cape Point for Boulders Beach to meet the Penguins.
- 1.00pm
- Lunch at Harbour House Kalk Bay, offering delicious seafood with excellent views.
- 3.00pm
- · Return to the hotel.
- · Remainder of day at own arrangements.
